Get Skills

- SASUs are where like minded adults can get together to offer help and support around a particular skill.
- It's also where our county experts share, train and validate your skills to develop what you can offer.
- Each has a SASU manager as the point of contact that will regularly email opportunities to join in. It's up to you how much you get involved.

Get Programmes

- SASUs can help you develop your programme by offering expertise, equipment and sessions to young people (and adults!)
- It might be an international awareness evening for beavers or a shooting competition for Explorers.
